



Circle in a Square

Note:

6" Acrylic Square -You can make this a Patriotic square!
Just change the Second or Fourth Row to Red.

Materials

1 Worsted Weight, White
1 Worsted Weight, Navy
Small Amount of Red worsted weight (optional)
Hook Size G

Direction

Ch 4, Join to form ring.

Rnd 1) Ch 3. Make 13 Dc in ring. Join to top of Ch 3.

Rnd 2) Ch 4, in base of Ch 3 of previous Rnd, make 1 Dc. (Dc. Ch 1, Dc) in next Dc. Repeat between () around. Join in third Ch of Ch 4. Fasten off.

Rnd 3) Join new color with SL St in any Ch 1 space. 1 Sc in same space.
Ch 2, Sc in next Ch 1 Space. Repeat from around. Join.

Rnd 4) Ch 4 (Counts as 1 treble), 3 Trebles in same stitch. *2 Dc in chain space, Dc on next Sc, 2 Hdc next, 1 Hdc in Sc, 2 Hdc next.
4 Trebles in next (Corner made). Repeat from* around, Join to top of first treble.

Row 5) Sc around you will have 3 Sc in each corner. Join.

Row 6) Ch 3, dc in each Sc around- having 3 Dc in each corner.
Join to top of Ch 3. Fasten off.
