



## Beaded Coaster

### (Set of 6)

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2004-2007

## Materials

1 Cone, Lily sugar 'N Cream Cotton Yarn

(Cone will make several sets of 6 – double up on the beads accordingly)

36- Faceted Beads (6 for Each Coaster)

Crochet Hook Size: **G**

**Note:** Draw yarn through beads before starting project. String all 36 beads. While working project, do Not Turn Rounds. Beading occurs on the last round. You will push down the un-used beads on the un-used strand of yarn as you work. Also, Ch 3- counts as Dc. Ch 4, Dc in same space counts as beginning V-stitch.

## Coaster

Rnd 1) Ch 5, Join to form Circle, Ch 3.

11 Dc into Circle, join. (12 Dc)

Rnd 2) Ch 4, Dc in same space (Counts as beginning V-Stitch). \*Ch 2, Skip 1, (Dc, Ch 1, Dc) all in next Dc (V-Stitch made). Repeat\*around, end with Ch 2; join with SL St to 3<sup>rd</sup> chain of Ch 4, SL St in Ch 1 space of V stitch. (6 V-stitches)

Rnd 3) Ch 4, 1 Dc in same space. Ch 2. 1 Dc in next space.

\*Ch 2 (1 Dc, Ch 1, 1 Dc all in next space). Ch 2, Dc in next space. Repeat\* around. End with Ch 2; join to 3<sup>rd</sup> Ch of Ch 4. SL St to Ch 1 space, Ch 1.

Rnd 4) \*Skip next Dc and Ch 2 space, 3 Dc in top of next Dc, Ch 1, Draw up a bead, Ch 1 (to secure the bead), Ch 1, 3 Dc in top of same Dc. Ch 1, Sc between V stitch, Ch 1. Repeat\*around. End with Join to first SL St, Fasten off.
